Directions to Cash's Arena: 17720 SW Elsner Rd, Sherwood, OR 97140

Coming from the close North- drive south on 99W toward Newberg, turn right at the 2nd Sherwood light, you will be on Roy Rogers Road

Coming from the far North or South on I-5 - take Exit 289, Tualatin-Sherwood Road, go West approximately 4.5 miles until 99W, go straight across 99W, Tualatin-Sherwood Road becomes Roy Rogers Road.

From the East- Take 205 until it becomes I-5, exit to the right (north) stay in the right lane, it will become the exit 289 lane, turn left onto Tualatin Road, then proceed as above.

Once on Roy Rogers, proceed 2.4 miles to Elsner Road, turn right onto SW Elsner Road, after the 1st curve, **SLOW DOWN.** **The driveway is immediately after a 30MPH yellow road sign, on the right. Turn between white fencing at 17720.**

There is parking behind the Arena and to the left side if the front part is filled. **There is no RV parking available on site.**

Veterinary Information (not in attendance)

Directions to Emergency Veterinary Clinic of Tualatin (EVCOT):

From the Cash's, turn left out of their driveway. Turn Left onto Roy Rogers Road. Stay on Roy Rogers Road. When you cross 99W, the road turns into Tualatin-Sherwood Road. In about 4 miles, turn right onto Martinazzi (there will be a Fred Meyers on your left as you turn), turn right on SW Warm Springs, turn right onto SW Tonka, and the destination will be on your right. You will see a bright red **Emergency Veterinary** sign.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Shows and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium list.

ENTRY INFORMATION: Entries close at 12:00 noon PDT, April 2, 2025, or when a total of 8 hours of judging time per judge has been reached. Fees must accompany entries. **All checks and money orders should be made payable to Sherwood Dog Training Club or SDTC, mailed or delivered to, Darlene Brushwein, 7920 SW Gearhart Drive, Beaverton, OR 97007.**

Telephone, telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent, or if the dog is entered in a class in which it is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly.

The Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

No Entry fees will be refunded after the closing date except for Bitches that come into season. For Bitches in season; a refund less \$4.00 per class entered with a written request of the owner or handler before the start of judging of the Trial on the day of the Trial will be given.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

JUDGING: The judging will start promptly as specified in entry confirmation. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. The Club will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class; it is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate any dog, its owner or its agent when the dog's presence is needed in the judging ring. Judges will NOT wait for any dog holding up a class.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS: If you provide an e-mail address on your entry you agree that judging programs and armband numbers may be sent to you via e-mail. Acknowledgments, arm band number and judging program will be sent after closing via email. Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, contact the Trial Secretary at (503) 701-9608. Anyone wishing a mailed copy of the schedule must provide a self-addressed stamped envelope to the Trial Secretary.

LIABILITY: Sherwood Dog Training Club will do all possible to ensure the welfare of dogs and exhibitors alike but does not assume responsibility nor liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators at these events. In the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from a life-threatening condition, the owner/handler/exhibitor of that dog and owner of the vehicle waives all claims for damages against the Sherwood Dog Training Club.

EXHIBITOR RESPONSIBILITY: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable disease and have appropriate vaccinations.

TRANSFERS: Will be allowed at these Obedience Trials

CLEAN UP INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE RINGS: The rings are the responsibility of the exhibitors. Your cooperation in exercising your dog before entering the ring will be appreciated. Exhibitors are expected to keep the area around their crates and vehicles clean, including cleanup in all parking areas.

CHILDREN: It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the trial. Parents are expected to always supervise their children.

**Participants must be responsible for their personal hygiene and health.
If you are not feeling well, please stay home.**

We are fortunate to have a wonderful facility for our Obedience Trials.

The Cash's Arena is on private property, and we MUST respect the owners and their property.

Please be sure to always clean up after your dog. There is a poop garbage can near the port-a-potty. Do not put any poop in any indoor containers.

There is NO SMOKING on any part of the property.

If you plan on being at the Trial early and for most of the day, please park behind the arena and forward enough that someone can park behind you. Every effort will be made to find who is parked behind you if you need to leave before the person behind you.

Crating is available on the cement area above the arena, and in a couple of empty stalls. Crating can also be done on the dirt surface of the arena. On Saturday and Sunday, a warm-up ring may be set up.

PLEASE CHECK IN AT THE ARMBAND STATION.

Armband station will be near the ring.

The Armband steward will check you in.

Exhibitors in multiple classes will get one armband.

If you misplace or lose your armband, let the Armband Steward know for a replacement.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Instructions 1.(Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard). 2.The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. 3.(Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division. 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
